AN INDIGENOUS VOICE TO PARLIAMENT

A new book by Frank Brennan SJ, <u>An Indigenous Voice to Parliament</u> (Garratt, 2023), "fairly outlines both the 'Yes' case and the 'No' case, so that voters can make up their own minds before casting their vote in the referendum" according to the publisher.

In an <u>open letter</u> to Federal parliamentarians, leaders of Australia's major religious organisations call MPs "to find ways to collaborate constructively across political divides."

Senator Jacinta Nampijinpa Price is one of the <u>leading voices</u> of the No campaign against the proposed Voice to Parliament, as is <u>Warren Mundine</u>.
