COURT RULING ON TELEHEALTH AND VAD

Archbishop Peter Comensoli has welcomed the Federal Court's ruling that voluntary assisted dying (VAD) is considered suicide under criminal law, clarifying it is not lawful for doctors to give patients information about euthanasia by means of telehealth, email or phone call.
